## Notes:

The definition of a Wallaroo is based upon the definition for the status of a Wallaby. The status of a Wallaby has changed over the years with any player selected and played in an Australian Team were counted as a Wallaby. Additionally, if selected in a tour side, the status of Wallaby was accorded to the player. More recently, players have been allocated numbers for playing with the Australian team. The club has since adopted this method, but previous numbering remains. The Criteria now adopted by the Australian Rugby Union is:

There are essentially three categories of Wallabies (agreed in 2012) outside of those who are Test capped.

- 1. Any player that is selected in a Wallabies squad and tours overseas with the national team is considered an Uncapped Wallaby, even if for any reason he is unable to play in a match.
- 2. Any player who was selected to assemble with a Wallabies squad and trained with the team in the lead-up to a Test or touring match, during the period of the non-replacement rule in International Rugby is considered an Uncapped Wallaby.
- 3. Any player in the replacement rule era who has been selected in a Wallabies Test squad or touring match, is part of the 22-man game day squad but is not called on during the course of the match is considered an Uncapped Wallaby.
